

Pandema, pandemmy? What is that word? The adults keep talking about it, I heard.




I'm home with my Mama, Papa and Nana, I think it's been days, maybe weeks, it's bananas!




Things have changed in my neighbourhood,

"We stay home not to spread germs to one another, That makes us all Superheroes - we're protecting each other!"






"I'm a hero too? I guess I'll need a cape! But what if I catch it, will I be okay?"

"I guess I won't have a birthday party this year, How can we make friends and family feel near?"




"We can bake a cake together and I'll cook your favourite dish, We'll video call your friends as you make a birthday wish!"






I think I know now, what I felt from the start,
