An easy way to raise funds for Save the Children is to fundraise online using our online tool. We provide everything you need to securely collect credit card donations from your personal contacts.

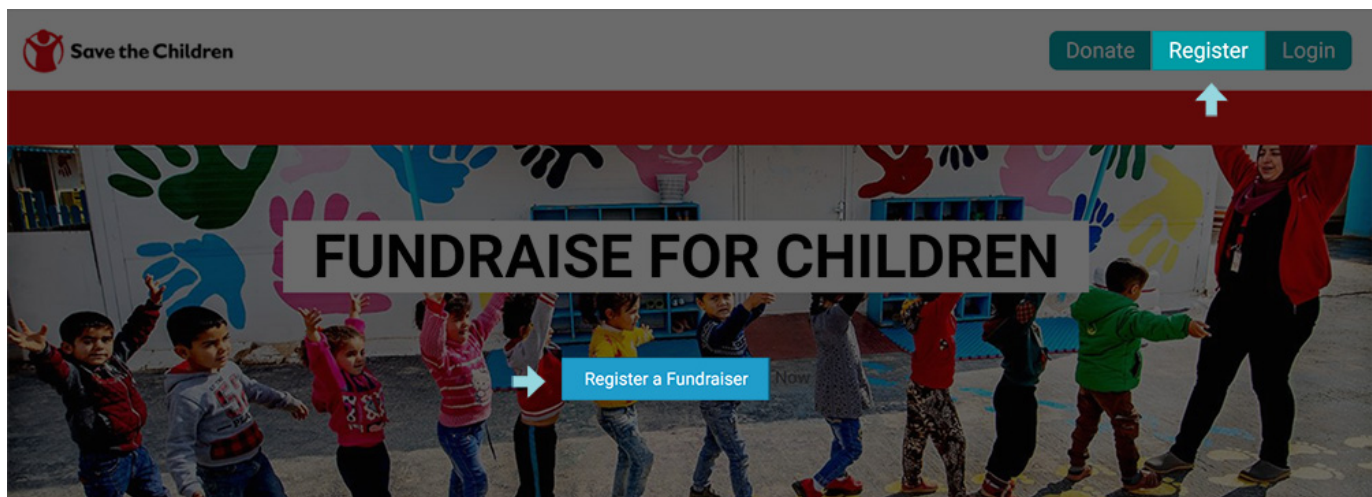
Ideas for fundraising online:

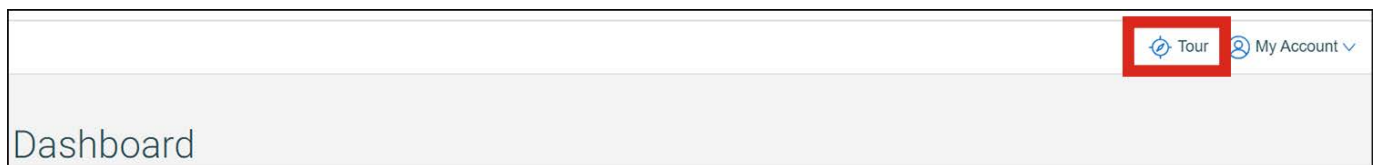
