MALNUTRITION TREATMENT \$200

Millions of children worldwide are facing acute malnutrition, a deadly threat to their survival. Provide life-saving treatment for children over several weeks, including high-nutrient peanut paste, fortified milk, antibiotics, and medical care.

FOOD BASKET \$75

Families recovering from disasters, fleeing conflict, or facing financial hardship often struggle to feed their children. Help sustain a family with food staples such as rice, dried fish, beans, flour, and oil.

FOODBANK \$50

Addressing food insecurity for Indigenous children is essential for their wellbeing. Rising costs of living and other factors are making it increasingly difficult for many families in Canada to feed their children. Provide food items and grocery store vouchers in local medical clinics and hospitals to support the health of Indigenous children and families in their communities.

PLUMPY'NUT® PEANUT PASTE \$60

Provide a child experiencing malnutrition with several weeks of life-saving therapeutic food. Packed with protein, this enriched peanut paste gives a child the nutrition they need to gain weight and return to health.

HEALTH AND NUTRITION: HEALTH CARE



MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT \$100

Mental health support is a priority for many Indigenous communities. Support a child through local mental health programs that are culturally sensitive and grounded in Indigenous knowledge.



STOCK A MEDICAL CLINIC \$75

Stock a medical clinic with syringes, stethoscopes, blood pressure monitors, thermometers, measuring tapes, rapid tests, and bandages. These are life-saving in the hands of health workers in rural communities with limited options.

MATERNAL AND NEWBORN HEALTH \$90

Many babies are born in remote locations or displacement camps with limited or no access to essential clinical services. This gift supports the safe delivery of babies and provides routine immunizations for newborns through local clinics and community-based health teams. It also provides critical care for their moms before and after delivery, as well as guidance on breastfeeding and newborn health.



MEDICINE AND VACCINES \$50

Provide children with life-saving protection: antibiotics, rehydration salts, zinc, other essential medicines, vaccines and routine immunizations for diseases such as cholera, measles, and polio, along with training for health workers and parents.

SOLAR WATER SYSTEM \$200

Access to safe and sustainable water is a major challenge for many children and families, especially in remote or dry locations. Help install and maintain a solar-powered water system to provide a reliable supply of clean drinking water for a large region.

CLEAN WATER PROJECT \$50

Give access to clean water! Help drill a well, install a pump, or build a washroom for a community to reduce the spread of deadly diseases. With a clean water source nearby, children can go to school instead of walking long distances to collect water for their families.

SCHOOL WATER PROJECT \$125

Help provide clean drinking water and handwashing stations for an entire school. Clean water protects from diarrheal diseases, which are one of the leading causes of death among children.

2 GOATS + 1 SHEEP \$140

With two goats and a sheep, a family can focus on financial stability. The sale of milk, offspring, wool, and fertilizer can generate an income to overcome poverty.



BEES \$50

Bees provide a family with honey and beeswax that can provide income. These busy pollinators can also increase annual crop production to enhance food security.



FAVOURITE

1 GOAT + 2 CHICKS \$75

Goats and chicks provide an essential daily supply of milk and eggs to help nourish a growing child. Livestock can be bred to expand the family's income.



LIVESTOCK BUNDLE \$520

Give a cow, a donkey, two goats, and two sheep! This hearty herd of animals will provide families with food and marketable items year after year.

SEEDS AND TOOLS \$75

Climate-appropriate native seeds can help a home or community garden to grow. A child's family will also receive tools, such as hoes, shovels, and watering cans, along with rich organic fertilizer and instruction to help their garden succeed.

A cow and goats are the foundation of a thriving dairy farm. Vital for children, milk quenches thirst, and provides essential vitamins and minerals that can stave off malnutrition.

Chicks grow into productive egg-layers, providing protein-rich eggs to feed a child. Extra eggs can be sold to cover health and living essentials.

NEEDED**


Every girl has the right to an education. But too often, families can't afford school costs for all their children and deprioritize their daughters' education. When girls stay in school, it delays marriage and childbirth, and provides them with an opportunity to become self-sufficient. Books, learning materials, and access to education allow girls to pursue their dreams.



SCHOOL LUNCHES \$50

Lunch provided at school is sometimes the only meal a child receives each day. Provide a month of school lunches for two children so they can focus on learning and not their hungry bellies.

BOOKS \$50

By reading books from Indigenous authors and illustrators, Indigenous children can embrace their heritage and find acceptance, particularly in remote communities where resources may be limited. You can give a child the gift of books that represent them, their stories, and their communities.


SCHOOL SUPPLIES \$30

Set a child up for educational success by sending them to the classroom with a backpack full of school supplies like notebooks, learning materials, pencils, and erasers.

SCHOOL FOR REFUGEE AND DISPLACED CHILDREN \$175

Children displaced by war, natural disasters, and other emergencies lose access to education, which limits their ability to succeed later in life. Provide a temporary classroom within a displacement camp for children whose schooling has been disrupted.

GIRLS' EMPOWERMENT

PROTECT A GIRL FROM CHILD, EARLY AND FORCED MARRIAGE **\$200**

Each year, 12 million girls marry before the age of 18. Child, early and forced marriage often ends a girl's education, limits her ability to find a good job, forces her into adult responsibilities, and puts her at risk of early pregnancies and maternal death. Help tackle the root causes of this gender-based violence and change discriminatory social norms through education, awareness campaigns, and advocacy in conjunction with youth, parents, teachers, and community leaders.

GIRL-FRIENDLY SPACE **\$50**

Many girls who are fleeing from conflict or living in displacement camps are at high risk of violence. Help create a safe place for girls to access psychosocial and gender-based violence support, camaraderie, and education.

FOUNDATIONS GIFTS OF JOY

Pregnancy and childbirth complications are one of the leading causes of death for girls in Mali, Niger, and Sierra Leone. The FOUNDATIONS project provides sexual and reproductive health services and education to girls in these three countries.

FOUNDATIONS Gifts of Joy support girls to learn their rights, stay in school, and decide whether to marry and have children.

The Government of Canada will match FOUNDATIONS gifts 20 TIMES until December 31.



GIRLS' LATRINES \$125

Girls who have access to safe and sanitary toilet facilities stay in school longer. Support girls' right to education by providing girls' washrooms.



SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH \$75

Support youth—both girls and boys—to access adolescent-friendly health care and learn about sexual and reproductive health, respectful relationships, their rights, and the risks of early pregnancies to themselves, their futures, and their babies.



GIRL'S DIGNITY KIT \$30

Supply a girl with hygiene basics so she can feel comfortable and go to school during her period: reusable and disposable menstrual pads, soaps, washcloths, underwear, materials to make pads, and an information pamphlet about periods.

EMERGENCIES: URGENT NEEDS AND SUPPLIES

DROUGHT RESPONSE KIT **\$100**

Climate emergencies like drought have devastating results on food security for children. Help a child survive a drought by providing emergency food, high-nutrient peanut paste for malnutrition, and clean water.

CASH ASSISTANCE IN EMERGENCIES **\$50**

Cash transfers are a fast, secure, and reliable way to help a family in crisis. Give families the flexibility to purchase what they urgently need—food, clothing, baby supplies, heating fuel, and other emergency necessities—while supporting their local economy.



EMERGENCY HEALTH UNIT **\$150**

Help deploy a rapid-response team of pediatric specialists to treat children in emergencies, conflicts, and climate disasters. Health professionals, medical supplies, and a health facility are quickly coordinated to provide urgent care, including surgeries, wound dressings, maternity and newborn care, and nutrition support.

FAVOURITE



EMERGENCY FOOD \$50

Children caught in concurrent crises such as drought, soaring food prices, and war are in desperate need of reliable, nutritious food to keep them healthy. Provide emergency food for a child where and when it's urgently needed.



HYGIENE KIT \$35

Children displaced by conflict or climate disasters leave everything behind. Give a child's family a hygiene kit loaded with basics like soap, toothpaste and toothbrushes, shampoo, menstrual pads, diapers, and cleansers.

KITCHEN SUPPLIES \$50

Help families displaced by emergencies prepare simple meals with the gift of basic kitchen supplies, including a stove, pots, pans, cups, plates, and utensils.

CLEAN WATER KIT \$25

A clean water kit—including clean water, soap, a bucket, and water-purifying tablets—helps to maintain hygiene and health. This can be a literal life-saver for families displaced by conflict or overwhelmed by climate disasters.

EMERGENCIES: PROTECTION AND SUPPORT

CARE FOR A CHILD FLEEING CONFLICT **\$225**

Children fleeing conflict have been forced from their homes, schools, and sometimes their families. Provide a child with the care they need to endure the chaos of conflict: emergency food, health care, a clean water kit, psychosocial support, and a safe place to play and access education.

FAMILY SURVIVAL KIT **\$125**

Provide emergency shelter and bedding sets for a family who have fled their home. This kit includes supplies such as tarp, rope, blankets, bed mats, and mosquito nets, as well as hygiene items such as soaps, toothpaste, menstrual pads, and diapers.

FAVOURITE



PROTECT AN UNACCOMPANIED CHILD **\$100**

Assist a child who has lost or been separated from their parents due to conflict, natural disaster, or other crises. This gift provides an unaccompanied child with protection and essentials such as food, shelter, medical care, and counselling. It also helps reunite a child with their family.

EMERGENCY BACKPACKS **\$45**

The increasing number of climate emergencies like flooding and forest fires regularly force entire Indigenous communities in northern Canada to be evacuated. Provide an emergency backpack that contains a hygiene kit, ID bracelet, flashlight, toy, notebook and pen, along with emergency training to keep a child safe.

WINTER WARMTH KIT **\$75**

Many children who have fled to displacement camps need to survive the cold winter with minimal shelter. Bundle a child in warmth with a coat, toque, mittens, sweater, socks, and boots.
