

WHERE NEEDED MOST

URGENT CLEAN WATER KIT

Give the gifts of hygiene and health to families displaced by conflict or overwhelmed by climate disasters. A clean water kit includes simple items with the power to save lives: clean water, soap, a bucket, and water-purifying tablets.

EMERGENCY BACKPACKS (IN CANADA)

The increasing number of climate emergencies, like extreme weather, flooding, and forest fires, regularly force entire Indigenous communities in northern Canada to be evacuated. Provide an emergency backpack that contains a hygiene kit, ID bracelet, flashlight, toy, notebook, and pen. This gift also provides emergency preparedness training to keep children safe during climate emergencies.

FEED A CHILD IN CRISIS

Nutritious, regular meals disappear fast when children are caught in multiple crises such as war, drought, and soaring food prices. Send emergency food to a child where and when it's urgently needed.

WINTER WARMTH KIT

Many children who have fled to displacement camps need to survive the cold winter with minimal shelter. Bundle a child in warmth with a coat, toque, mittens, sweater, socks, and boots.

DROUGHT RESPONSE KIT

Climate emergencies like drought can devastate a family's food security. Help a child survive by giving them emergency food, clean water, and high-nutrient peanut paste to treat severe malnutrition.

PROTECT AN UNACCOMPANIED CHILD

In a conflict or disaster, children who've lost or been separated from their parents are truly the most vulnerable. Help restore some safety and comfort with essentials like food, shelter, medical care, and counselling. This gift can even help reunite a child with their family.

FAMILY SURVIVAL KIT

Give a family who has fled their home the essentials to stay comfortable and clean. This kit includes blankets, bed mats, tarp, rope, and mosquito nets, as well as soaps, toothpaste, menstrual pads, and diapers.

EMERGENCY MOBILE HEALTH CLINIC

Help deploy a rapid-response team of pediatric specialists to treat children in emergencies and conflicts. Health professionals, medical supplies, and a health facility are quickly coordinated to provide urgent care, including surgeries, wound dressings, maternity and newborn care, and malnutrition treatment.



CARE FOR A CHILD FLEEING CONFLICT

Children fleeing conflict have been forced from their homes, schools, and sometimes their families. Give a child the care they need to survive and recover: emergency food, health care, a clean water kit, psychosocial support, and a safe place to play and learn.

CHICKS

Chicks grow into productive egg layers, providing protein-rich eggs that keep children growing and strong. Families can also sell extra eggs to cover their household and health costs.

Goats and chicks provide a daily supply of nourishing milk and eggs for a child's breakfast. Plus, a family can breed this lovable livestock to earn more income.

BUSY BEES

Bees provide honey and beeswax to a family who needs the extra income. These busy pollinators can also increase annual crop production, providing a family with more healthy food to eat or sell.



GIRL'S PERIOD KIT

Help a girl stay comfortable during her period so she can stay in school. Give her essentials like reusable and disposable menstrual pads, soap, washcloths, underwear, materials to make pads, and information about periods.

SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

Empower girls and boys with adolescent-friendly health care and vital education on sexual and reproductive health, respectful relationships, and their rights. This crucial knowledge also helps them understand the risks of early pregnancies to themselves, their futures, and their babies.

GIRLS WASHROOMS

Never underestimate the profound influence of a simple toilet. Safe and sanitary washrooms keep girls in school longer so they can gain the knowledge and confidence to reach their full potential.

PROTECT A GIRL FROM EARLY AND FORCED MARRIAGE


Each year, 12 million girls marry before the age of 18. Child, early and forced marriage often ends a girl's education, limits her ability to find a good job, forces her into adult responsibilities, and puts her at risk of early pregnancies and death during childbirth. Help tackle the root causes of this gender-based violence, and change discriminatory social norms through education, awareness campaigns, and advocacy alongside youth, parents, teachers, and community leaders.

HEALTH & NUTRITION

CRITICAL MEDICINE AND VACCINES

Give children the essentials to survive: medicines, antibiotics, rehydration salts, zinc, vaccines, and routine immunizations for diseases like cholera, measles, and polio.

FOODBANK (IN CANADA)

Rising costs of living and other factors are making it increasingly difficult for many families in Canada to feed their children. Provide food items and grocery store vouchers in local medical clinics and hospitals to support the health of Indigenous children and families in their communities.

VITAL CLEAN WATER PROJECT

Help drill a well, install a pump, or build a washroom. With clean water near their homes, children can stay healthy and replace their water collection time with school time.

EMERGENCY FAMILY FOOD BASKET

\$75

Families recovering from disasters, fleeing conflict, or facing financial hardship often struggle to feed their children. Help parents prepare nutritious daily meals at home with staples such as rice, dried fish, beans, flour, and oil.

MOM AND BABY HEALTH

\$75

Many babies are born in remote areas or displacement camps without access to essential clinical services. This gift helps mothers deliver their babies safely, and provides newborns with routine immunizations through local clinics and community health teams. It also gives mothers critical care before and after birth, and guidance on breastfeeding and newborn health.

STOCK A MEDICAL CLINIC

Basic medical supplies can become life-saving tools for rural health workers with limited resources. Stock a clinic with essentials like syringes, stethoscopes, blood pressure monitors, thermometers, measuring tapes, rapid tests, and bandages.

LIFE-SAVING PLUMPY'NUT® PEANUT PASTE

Feed a malnourished child with a six-week course of therapeutic food. Packed with protein, this enriched peanut paste has all the nutrition a little one needs to gain weight and get healthy again.

Mental health support is a vital part of a child's growth and wellness and is a priority for many Indigenous communities. Support a child in feeling seen and supported through local mental health programs that are culturally sensitive and grounded in Indigenous knowledge.

SCHOOL WATER PROJECT

Deadly diseases can spread through unclean water and unwashed hands. Help keep children clean and healthy with safe drinking water and handwashing stations for an entire school.

Acute malnutrition is a deadly threat to millions of children worldwide. You can help save a child's life with weeks of high-nutrient peanut paste, fortified milk, antibiotics, and medical care.
